## MINUTES OF THE US JCI SENATE FOUNDATION MEETING

Tulsa, Oklahoma - Jan. 16, 1987, 10:30 p.m.

Members present: Doug Hincker, Doc McCarty, George Fraser, Tony Dominiec.

President Doug Hincker reported that the first Honoray Trustee has been presented to Mrs. Charlotte Mungenast from St. Louis, Mo. Request was made by Hincker to solicit five more candidates by February 1 and vote on them in Gatlinburg, TN on February 21, 1987.
