COMMITTEE REPORTS:

<u>Scholarship Committee</u>: Trustees Sabella and Kolodner reported that scholarship information had been sent to all State Presidents, Regional Representatives, and all Foundation members. We would also like to have each state notify us of the number of applications received to be judged. Trustee Jim Hall will make up a display of all past scholarship recipients to be used at all of our meetings. This will be done by Tulsa, if he has the list of winners by then.

<u>Fundraising for Foundation</u>:

Sports Raffle - Trustee Bob Hunt reported that last year's raffle made \$1600. From this and suggestions from others, a memorabilia auction or raffle is being planned. There will be three areas - Jaycees, Sports, and Americana. We already have a picture of Henry Geisenber, a baseball signed by the 1966 Baltimore Orioles and we have been promised several other things.

<u>JCI Senate Liaison</u>: Trustee Hank Kolodner will talk to all regional reps this weekend about Foundation promotion. Because of the schedule this weekend, we will have no special fundraising.

OLD BUSINESS

<u>Guests Comments</u>: Region Rep, Bob Holbert, reported that Arizona is running the scholarship program for the first time this year and plans to run a golf tournament for the Foundation. Region Rep, Allan Hancock, reported that is has set a goal of \$10,000 to be raised in Region 4 this year.

Senate President Don Robertson reported that his meeting with the Jaycee President, Gary Thompson, went very well and feels that past issues will no longer be a problem.
